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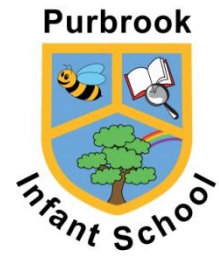

No Prime Drinks in School

Please can we ask that Prime drinks are not brought into school for your child to drink at lunchtime. We fully appreciate that Prime hydration drinks are extremely popular with the children and as a result we have noticed more and more of them creeping into the lunchboxes.

The labelling on the Prime Hydration drinks suggests that these drinks shouldn't be consumed by children under 15 years. Although these are not energy drinks, (these ones are labelled as Prime energy and these contain caffeine) they do pose a risk of vitamin toxicity if consumed in excess and therefore to ensure we follow the national guidance we respectfully ask they are not brought in for school.

Prime is also an expensive alternative for squash and the hype around these drinks can cause tension with our pupils.

Please can I take this opportunity to remind you that children are only allowed to drink water during the day and it is only acceptable for the children to have squash in a separate bottle in their lunch box. Thank you for your support around this issue!

Overcoming childhood anxiety: Online Meeting

The Hampshire Mental Health Support Team are putting on a workshop for parents to help them manage anxiety in children under 12. This will be highlighting when anxiety might be a problem (as opposed to a 'normal' developmental phase), different anxiety disorders and how these can be recognised and discussed. Exploring why treatment is important and a detailed overview of a Cognitive Behaviour Therapy approach. Key strategies to use within professional roles are highlighted, and the role of parental/adult behaviour (how they respond to the child's anxiety) is explored. When? Thursday 20 June 5.30-7.30pm.
