Summer Reading Challenge: 13 July - 07 September

On Monday the children were visited by staff from the School Library Service who introduced the Summer Reading Challenge to them.

The Summer Reading Challenge is a national scheme run by the Reading Agency with the aim of keeping children reading over the sixweek summer break. This year's theme is 'Marvellous Makers' which is all about being creative. The challenge encourages children aged 4 to 11 to read six books over the summer holidays and take part in fun activities that



promote physical and mental wellbeing. The children will be bringing home bookmarks with them today.
