Anti-Social Behaviour

We have received a rather upsetting email from the Doggy Day Centre in Elizabeth Road. In the email they state: "On a daily basis, morning and afternoons we have children from your school bashing our door, kicking our door and this morning (Wednesday) they were using sticks to bash the windows and doors, this behaviour stresses out and frightens our dogs. It's a daily occurrence now and it's not fair on the staff, the dogs or our dogs' owners." This is not the standard of behaviour we expect from our children so please ensure that your children are respectful to other people. Thank you.
