


Wonky Bars Sale – Message from the PTFA

Year 1 Educational Trip: Friday 21 March

Please can you ensure that your child arrives in school by 8.50am so that we are able to discuss with them the importance of listening to instructions; staying with their adult, and also have time to remind them of our expectations regarding behaviour.

PLEASE ENSURE THAT YOUR CHILD COMES TO SCHOOL WITH A WATER BOTTLE. WE DO NOT HAVE SPARES.

We will need to keep our lunches with us so could you send your child to a school with a **rucksack**.

The clothing children wear for their forest school sessions will be suitable for the trip. The children must wear sensible, waterproof footwear such as **wellington boots**. Please ensure they have **warm socks** with their wellies as Hillier Gardens have advised that children's feet can get cold. All children <u>must</u> wear <u>trousers</u> (they can wear non-school uniform trousers, but we advise against jeans if it is forecast to rain) and their school shirts/sweatshirts. Please ensure that your child has a <u>warm, waterproof coat</u> and a hat and gloves if cold.

If your child suffers from travel sickness, please give him/her a tablet (if you usually do this) at the beginning of the day. We will return to school in time for normal collection at 3.15pm.

Reminder: Red Nose Day: Friday 21 March/Thursday 20 March for Year 1

We will once again be supporting this worthwhile cause which is celebrating 40 years of charity work. They support local community organisations and brilliant change - makers here in the UK and across the globe. We are asking that the children come to school dressed in something red or any comic relief merchandise. Parental Consultations

Reporting Absence

A reminder that as well as telephoning the school, you can also report your child's absence via a company called **Studybugs** which enables you to go online via a phone or computer to report your child's absence securely. Lunch Menu

This is available for parents to view and order online. Please go to <u>https://app.schoolgrid.co.uk/</u> where you can view and order a lunch for your child.

Ordering in Advance: You can order in advance for the whole week (possibly longer). If you do this but then your child is not in school before 9.15am because you are late or are taking them to an appointment but you haven't informed us of this, **their lunch request will be cancelled** and you will need to provide them with a packed lunch. Whilst lunches are free to parents, the school has to pay for these.

If your child has an appointment and will be in late but requires a lunch that day, please let us know by leaving the school a voicemail. We have set up a designated telephone option – option 4. You can pre-order a lunch or leave us a message (before 9.15am). We just need you to let us know that your child will be in later that day. Please do not leave a message on the normal absence line as staff may not get to your message in time and your child's lunch will be cancelled.
